**Case C-427/12 *Commission v Parliament and Council* [2014] nyr.**

18 March 2014

Criteria in order to determine the choice between delegated act and implementing act (Articles 290 TFEU and 291 TFEU )- Implementing acts oblige the Commission to provide further detail in relation to the content of a legislative act - Article 80(1) - Biocidal products - Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 - Article 80(1) - European Chemicals Agency - Setting of fees by the Commission

Directive 98/8/EC — Article 2(1)(a) — Concept of ‘biocidal products’ — Product intended to act chemically on harmful organisms

Identification of a product as a pesticide or as a biocidal product - no harmonised rules at Community level covering either their production or their marketing of biocides - quantitative restrictions on imports and all measures having equivalent effect – Rule of reason
